- Connecticut Boating Sales totaled \$170.7 million in 2017 including powerboats, engines, trailers and aftermarket accessories.
- There were 92,058 Connecticut boat registrations in 2017.
- There are **7,313 boating industry jobs** in the state of Connecticut (direct and indirect).
- Boating businesses in Norwalk and the surrounding areas saw an increase of 10.4% in the number of powerboat units sold from 2016 to 2017.
- The recently-enacted Connecticut state budget reduces the state sales tax on the sale of new boats. motors, and trailers from 6.35 percent to 2.99 percent, which is expected to drive increased interest in purchasing at the Show.
