Superbowl Coach and Hall of Famer Tony Dungy To Keynote “Vision and Values” Leadership Luncheon

He joined Mike Ditka and Tom Flores as the only individuals to win the Super Bowl as both a player and head coach, and is also distinguished as being the first African American coach in history to achieve this major milestone. Dungy joined the Colts in 2002 after serving as the most successful head coach in Tampa Bay Buccaneers history.

In addition to his notable sports successes, Dungy has been involved with a wide variety of charitable organizations including the Fellowship of Christian Athletes, Athletes in Action, Mentors for Life, Big Brothers Big Sisters, Boys & Girls Club, the Prison Crusade Ministry and All Pro Dad. He also works with Basket of Hope, the Black Coaches Association National Convention, Indiana Black Expo, the United Way of Central Indiana and the American Diabetes Association.

He and his wife Lauren are the parents of ten children, seven of whom are adopted.
