

Hi everyone! This is the AskAnnie Podcast horse girl reviews on products you use!

As I sit down to record this podcast the temperature in Colorado is a refreshing 63 degrees, which my Alaskan friends would laugh at, but after the 90s its been here recently, it's a cool relief! I love this weather and it's perfect to ride in because you're able to get a good workout in without sweating excessively because of the heat. Too soon however the weather will be taking a drastic downturn and Maddie and I will be confined to the indoor arena with our jackets and long winter coats. Maddie grows an impressive winter coat, it's honestly an incredible body of work. Sometimes I think that she might be hoping we'll hop on a trailer back to Alaska and wants to be prepared in case the moment arises. Needless to say, her coat is intense. While this is fantastic for protecting her from the winter weather, it is a lot when it comes to winter workouts. One piece of equipment that is an absolute necessity for us, especially in the winter, is a cooler. One cooler that I use all winter long is the Rambo All-in-One fleece cooler by Horsecwear. Let's dive into what make this cooler unique.

To start, this cooler is exceptionally soft. Not going to lie, this is the blanket that I grab on chilly days to wrap around myself while sitting in cool bleachers before a lesson or on an early horse show morning. I've had this Rambo cooler for almost 10 years and it has maintained its softness and smooth texture. Another aspect of this exterior that I appreciate is that it doesn't pill or clump up, even after being used multiple times on sweaty horses without being washed. The exterior glossy sheen to this blanket is eye catching and boldly contrasts the white pearl border piping. While the composition of the Rambo cooler is beautiful, it's also incredibly functional. This cooler effectively wicks the moisture off of Maddie's coat, while still allowing her to cool down slowly and safely. These two aspects of the Rambo cooler are complimented by the superb fit of this tool. Maddie is fairly proportionate, but does have a muscular neck, that luckily, she uses effectively. This Rambo cooler is one continuous piece of material that goes from her tail and haunches, all the way up to in between her ears. It has hook and loop closure straps that go all the way up her neck and is slightly contoured around her throatlatch, to allow her to move around comfortably when she's cooling off in it. This design fits securely around Maddie's neck and leads down to another hook and loop strap around her chest and then down to an elastic surcingle strap around her belly, finally ending with a clipped tail loop behind her haunches. I really appreciate the security functions of this blanket, as even though Maddie might be tired after a long workout, a flapping cooler would probably not go over too well in the barn aisle.

Overall, the Rambo All-in-One fleece cooler by Horsecwear has become a staple product in my tack room. It's practical, yet luxurious features are complimented by a secure and proper fit making it a useful and stylish piece of equipment.
