

Hi everyone! This is the AskAnnie Podcast horse girl reviews on products you use!

Fall has finally arrived in Colorado, the leaves have started to change, the air is slightly cooler, a mild 70 instead of the scorching 90s we had earlier in the summer. And while the cooler weather is great, the one thing that is not a welcomed guest is the wind. It rips through the little valley that hosts the barn where I board Maddie and picks up all the dust, leaves and tumbleweeds in its path, somehow centering all of its wrath on Maddie's tail. I've talked before about how luxurious Maddie's hair is, but it is the perfect magnet for all the fall particles creating a chaotic and knotted mess. Since the weather is still fairly mild, I figured this cluster of hair would be the perfect place to test Cowboy Magic's Rosewater Shampoo AND Rosewater Conditioner. I fetched Maddie, and her horrendous tail from the pasture, and proceeded to bring her and the Cowboy Magic® Rosewater Shampoo AND Rosewater Conditioner to the washrack.

I first opened the Cowboy Magic® Rosewater Shampoo and discovered the semi-transparent golden liquid inside. This shampoo had a very silk-like quality, and seemed to roll out of bottle. It also smelt wonderfully clean and had a slight floral undertone. I wet Maddie's tail and proceeded to collect a small amount on my hand to apply to Maddie's tail. According to the instructions on the Cowboy Magic Rosewater Shampoo bottle, you can apply the shampoo directly or dilute it with water. I like to apply shampoo directly with my hands, because it helps me to thoroughly work the product into Maddie's tail. Using this approach, I worked the Cowboy Magic Rosewater Shampoo into Maddie's tail using my fingers to reach into the thickest sections. I have to admit, I didn't brush the fall mess out of Maddie's tail before getting it wet, so the Cowboy Magic Rosewater Shampoo was the first glimpse of detangling it had seen in a few days. I continued to apply the Cowboy Magic Rosewater Shampoo to Maddie's tail until it was thoroughly covered and sudsy. According to the Cowboy Magic website, the sudsing surfactants found in the Rosewater Shampoo are quick releasing, allowing for more suds which in turn helps for an easier rinsing and less buildup. As I began to rinse Maddie's tail, I saw this in action. The suds flowed easily off of Maddie's tail, even from the places deep within her tail. I was surprised at how quickly the Cowboy Magic® Rosewater Shampoo came out of Maddie's tail! Upon finishing the rinse, Maddie's tail felt squeaky clean and didn't have any film or residue left on it.

Next, I grabbed the Cowboy Magic® Rosewater Conditioner bottle, because with all of the wind and dust, Maddie's tail really needed some extra moisturizing attention. According to the Cowboy Magic website, the Cowboy Magic® Rosewater Conditioner works to neutralize the hair by demineralizing, which minimizes static and reduces trace minerals within the hair. The instructions on the back of the Cowboy Magic® Rosewater Conditioner bottle, recommend using a small amount of concentrated conditioner and working it into the hair, then letting it sit for about 2 minutes. The Cowboy Magic® Rosewater Conditioner was slightly denser than the Cowboy Magic® Rosewater Shampoo and a creamy white color. I again worked the formula in with my fingers, trying to get every strand I possibly could. After I had applied the Cowboy Magic® Rosewater Conditioner to Maddie's tail, I set a timer and let it sink in for a little over two minutes. As I rinsed Maddie's tail for a second time I was elated to see the tangles and debris from Maddie's start to fall out. Once the rinse was complete, I could easily pull my fingers through Maddie's tail and used a brush to comb through the thicker parts of her tail,

finding few tangles in those sections as well. By the end of our little spa day, Maddie's tail was tangle free and shining, and had a slight smell of clean roses.

Overall I really appreciate the quick effectiveness of the Cowboy Magic® Rosewater Shampoo and Rosewater Conditioner. They both were easy to apply, easy to remove, and left Maddie's tail feeling clean and moisturized.
