As equestrians, we know how important good nutrition can be. Even after being around horses my entire life, going to school, and being surrounded by equine professionals, I still sometimes second guess myself and am unsure of the choices I have when trying to provide Maddie with the best supplements. I was really excited when we decided to review SmartPaks because I knew I was about to gain a wealth of knowledge and Maddie was going to get fed supplements that were right for our situation.

For those of you that might not know, a SmartPak is a pre-packaged, pre-measured, container of supplements, all ready to open and give to your horse daily. The process began with a fantastic phone call from Danielle, a supplement expert at SmartPak. From the get-go Danielle was kind, pleasant and incredibly knowledgeable on all things supplements. She began by asking Maddie's and my routine; how often we rode, what our training sessions consisted of, our competition schedule, what type of area Maddie lived in excetra.
