

Breaking News: End of social distancing measure and mandatory quarantine in the Netherlands

15 September 2021

An important announcement was made by the Dutch government this Tuesday. As of Saturday 25 September, a further relaxation of Covid measures will take place in the Netherlands, including the elimination of the social distancing measure. As of Wednesday 22 September, fully vaccinated travelers coming out of very high-risk areas are exempt from the mandatory guarantine*.

As METSTRADE we welcome the further relaxation of measures for the entire industry. All necessary precautions to ensure a safe and responsible event for all attendees are maintained by METSTRADE in accordance with our exhibitors and suppliers.

Which measures are in place at METSTRADE 2021?

To summarize, the following measures apply for all events in the Netherlands as of 25 September:

- The EU Digital Covid Certificate (DCC) is used to gain entry to an event. This means a person is either fully vaccinated, has a valid <u>negative Covid test</u> or valid <u>proof of recovery</u> (valid paper version is also approved)*;
- A health check (triage questionnaire) is performed to gain entry to an event;
- At locations or fringe events where fixed seating applies, the full visitor capacity can be used;
- Events which last more than one day are allowed, provided the DCC is re-checked daily.
