Highfield now offers small tenders from 2.4m, all the way up to a full line of heavyduty RIBs which will be at home on any ocean. With dealers and distributors in 48 countries and territories, Highfield Boats has become the top choice worldwide for leisure and commercial use.

Highfield rigid hull inflatable boats (RIBs) feature exclusive powder-coated aluminium hulls, whose swift rigid-hull inflatable boats are renowned for their durability and performance.

Highfield's state-of-the-art production facility is located in Weihai, China. Under European management, the facility now covers 26,000 sqm, employs 420 staff and has adopted the latest technologies available to guarantee production of the finest RIBs money can buy. Over 45,000 RIBS have been sold to date by Highfield Boats, which is the only international RIB manufacturer to have its own factory in China - other brands buy from Chinese suppliers.

Highfield Boats have built a reputation as the 'go to' supplier for some of the world's biggest sailing events. The RIB fleets are used for crowd control, escorts to competing yachts, sponsor hospitality and on the water management. The company has partnered the internationally renowned Extreme Sailing Series, the Route du Rhum, and the Vendee Globe, where more than 50 Highfield support RIBs were used during the start line spectacle in the last edition.
